

Welcome to St. Alban's!

The Parish Life Center is a multi-purpose building and is used by over sixty parish organizations. Please remember you are sharing this building with other organizations and their meetings, so be respectful of others.

To help ensure that all who use our Parish Life Center have a pleasant experience, please observe the following rules:

1. No bouncing balls in the hallways or off walls at anytime.
2. No food or drink is allowed in the Great Room (gym) –during practices, games and tournament play-including players and spectators. Only water bottles for players will be allowed.
3. Children are to be supervised at all times and if they are here for basketball they must stay in the gym- no roaming or running in the hallways.
4. Do not leave the front vestibule doors propped open-the building will lose heat or air conditioning which is costly for our parish.
5. Please check your schedule. The Great Room (gym) is for everyone's use so there are times when other things may be scheduled and basketball may not use it.
6. Players and coaches must wear non-marking athletic shoes in the Great Room (gym).
7. If you would like to use the scoreboard equipment or the Commons area, etc. for a Saturday or Sunday, you must call Basketball League President who will make the arrangements. Requests must be made on a timely basis not at the last minute.
8. Basketball has reserved use of the Great Room area only (gym). If you would like to use any other area in the building it must be reserved before hand through the parish office.
9. If a child in your supervision calls 911 for no apparent reason, your team will not be allowed to play or practice at St. Alban's anymore
10. Please be respectful of the Great Room (gym). We do not have 24-hour janitorial service. If you have made a mess or spilled anything please clean it up before you leave so the next team will have a clean area to play.
11. Gym Usage Schedule is posted along with the Basketball Practice Schedule.
However, the Gym Usage Schedule takes precedence over the Basketball Schedule.
12. No Pets allowed.

If we all follow the above guidelines we can be assured that all will enjoy the use of our Parish Life Center. If we find that a team continues to disregard the rules, their playing and practicing privileges may be revoked.
